
Word Problems That Use All Operations - Guided Lesson

Solve the following problems:

1) Jackson and his friends went to buy 5 dozen eggs. One dozen has 12 eggs. Laura buys 18 eggs. Kim buys 16 eggs. Drew buys 8 eggs. Jackson buys 5 eggs. How many more eggs do they need to buy to reach 5 dozen?



2) Andrew wants to mail 2 boxes of candies. Each box contains 20 candies. He bought 13 candies from a small shop, 10 from downtown, and 8 from a mall. How many more candies does he still need to buy?



3) Dobby has 35 shirts evenly spread over 5 boxes. He donated shirts for the boys' charity from one box. The first boy got 2 shirts and the second boy got 3 shirts. How many shirts are remaining in the box for the boy's charity?
