### Explanation to #1

Step 1) 1 hundred = 10 tens  
= 100 ones

Now figure out how many ones you can make from 8 hundreds.

Step 2) 8 hundreds = 800 ones.

So the answer will be 'b'.

### Explanation to #2

Step 1) First see what is being asked of you.

Step 2) The answer will be: - 6 hundred 5 tens 4 ones.

Six hundred-fifty-four.

### Explanation to #3

Step 1) First see what is being asked.

Step 2)

As you can count the first section there are 3 – 100 piece figures.

Then second, you can see 2 – 10 piece squares

Third, you can see 3 single piece figures.

The answer will be: - 323
