Write expressions when solving a real-world or mathematical problems.

The variable s represents the number of additional cups of syrup that Lisa buys. The variable t represents the total number of pancakes she eats with the syrup. With 2 additional cups of syrup, how many pancakes will Lisa eat?

$$t = 4s$$

Explanation:

The variable t represents the total number of pancakes.

The variable s represents the number of cups of syrup Lisa buys.

$$s = 2$$

$$t = 4s$$

$$t = 4 \times 2$$

$$t = 8$$

She will eat 8 pancakes.
