
Counting Money - Guided Lesson Explanation


Explanation#1

The beach ball costs 3 ¢. Look for the purse that has the same number of coins as the cost of the beach ball. Each penny is worth 1 ¢. The purse you are looking for must have 6 coins in it. The first purse has 6 coins. Draw a line connecting the beach ball to the first purse.



Explanation#2

The box costs 3 ¢. The pencils cost 5 ¢. Look for the purse that has the same number of coins as the cost of the box and the pencils. Each penny is worth 1 ¢. Connect the purse with 3 coins to the box. Connect the purse with 5 coins to the pencil.



Explanation#3

The paddle costs 4 ¢. Look for the piggybank that has the same number of coins as the cost of the paddle. Each penny is worth 1 ¢. The piggybank you are looking for must have 4 coins in it. The first piggybank has 4 coins. Draw a line connecting the paddle to the first piggybank.
