**Simple Division with Remainders- Guided Lesson Explanation**

The amount which left over after division is known as remainder. When writing the answer to a quotient with a remainder. We write it as:

(Amount that can evenly be divided) ("remainder") (amount left over)

**Explanation#1**

Here we divide 15 by 5. This goes in three times evenly.

$$\begin{array}{r} 3 \\ \hline 5 \overline{)15} \\ \underline{15} \\ 0 \end{array}$$

After division we get remainder that is 0

So the answer is 5 r 0

**Explanation#2**

Here we divide 23 by 7. This goes in evenly 3 times, but leaves a remainder of 2.

$$\begin{array}{r} 3 \\ \hline 7 \overline{)23} \\ \underline{21} \\ 2 \end{array}$$

After division we will get the remainder that is 2.

So the answer is 3 r 2



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### Explanation#3

Here we divide 10 by 4. This goes in evenly 2 times and leaves a remainder of 2.

$$\begin{array}{r} 2 \\ 4 \overline{)10} \\ \underline{8} \\ 2 \end{array}$$

After division we will get the remainder that is 2

So the answer is 2 r 2.
