Symmetry - Step-by-Step Lesson


Draw the other half to match.



Explanation:

Symmetry is when an object has equal means (parts) within itself.

Reflection Symmetry



This is when one side is a reflection (mirror-like) of the other side. As you can see to the left, our rhombus has two equal sides. This can run in any direction.

Let's look at the problem now. So, for symmetry to appear we would have to draw the other half. After drawing, the image will be like this.
