**When converting milliliters and liters remember:
1000 milliliter mL is equivalent to 1 Litter (L)**

Example 1) $1 \text{ L} \times 1000 = 1 \text{ mL}$

Example 2) $21.3 \text{ L} \times 1000 = 2130 \text{ mL}$

Example 3) $4000 \text{ mL} \div 1000 = 4 \text{ L}$

Example 4) $21580 \div 1000 = 21.58 \text{ L}$
