Write the dollar amount as cents.

Solution:



This is 50 dollars. \$50



This is 20 dollars. \$20



This is 5 dollars. It is worth 500 cents. \$5 or \$5.00



This is 1 dollar. It is worth 100 cents. \$1 or \$1.00



This coin is called a dime. It is worth 10 cents or 10¢.



This coin is called a nickel. It is worth 5 cents or 5¢.



This coin is called one cent or a penny. We write it as 1¢.

Step 1

Since \$1 = 100¢, so \$55 = 5500 ¢

Step 2

Also, \$0.5 = 50¢

Step 3

Total amount in cents = 5500 + 50 = 5550¢
