To solve the given expression we have to first remove the sign of % by dividing the number by 100.

So the new expression will be

$$\frac{15}{100} \times \frac{40}{1}$$

Multiply the given expression:

$$\frac{600}{100}$$

Simplify the expression to its lowest terms

6
