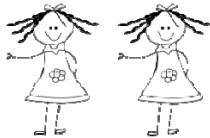
Smith, Anderson, and Clark made dolls. After a week, they made enough dolls. The diagram below shows the number of dolls that they have made.

Explanation:

Step 1) Count the number of dolls of three children.
