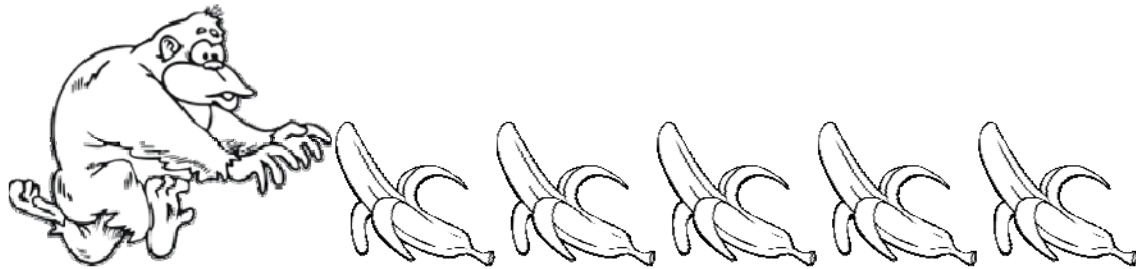


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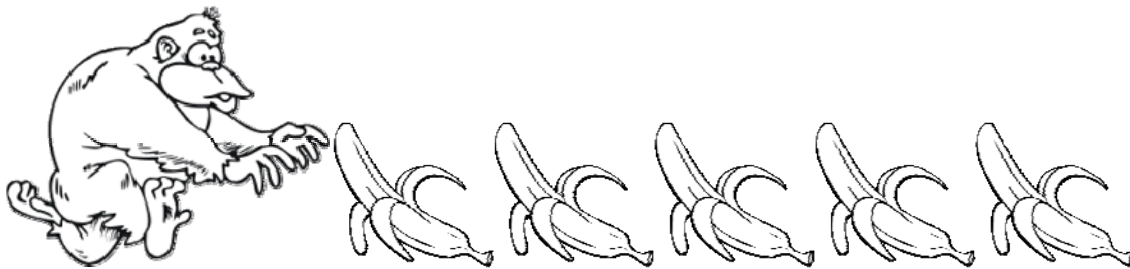
Horizontal Addition Math Facts and Story Problems Step-by-Step Lesson

Problem: Albert the ape has 6 bananas. He sees 5 more bananas and collects them. How many bananas does Albert the ape have now?



Explanation: The starting number in the problem is 6 and number of extra bananas is 5.

We can redraw this as:



$$6 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 1$$

or $6 + 5$

When adding 5 more to 6, we just count up 5 places from 6.

6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11

1 2 3 4 5

or $6 + 5 = 11$
