Measuring Time in Minutes - Step-by-Step Lesson

Lesson 1 - Measuring Time in Minutes.

- 1. What time is it shown on the clock?
- 2. If Ron has class 3 hours after the time shown on the clock, what is the starting time of the class?



Explanation 1:

Step 1) Analog clocks use hands to show us hours and minutes. The little hand shows hours and big hand tells us minutes. So as we can see by the clock it is 6 o'clock.

Step 2) The class starts 3 hours after the present time shown on the clock. The time shown on the clock is 6 o' clock. So we have to add 3 more hours in 6 o' clock i.e. 9 o' clock.

Answer:

 $\begin{bmatrix} 10 & 12 & 1 & 2 \\ 9 & 4 & 5 & 3 \\ 8 & 7 & 6 & 5 \end{bmatrix}$

- a) The time shown on the clock is 6 o' clock.
- b) The class starts at 9 o $^{\prime}$ clock.
