### Sum and Difference Fraction Word Problems - Guided Lesson Explanation

#### Explanation to #1

You can find out how much more Kate ate by subtracting  $\frac{3}{5}$  from  $\frac{4}{5}$ .

Subtract the numerator.

$$\frac{4}{5} - \frac{3}{5} = \frac{1}{5}$$

Kate ate  $\frac{1}{5}$  of a cup more than Natasha.

#### Explanation to #2

Find how many miles Robin walks in all by adding  $\frac{3}{6}$  to  $\frac{1}{6}$ .

Add the numerator.

$$\frac{3}{6} + \frac{1}{6} = \frac{4}{6}$$

Robin walked  $\frac{4}{6}$  of a mile in all.

#### Explanation to #3

Find the number of pots served by adding  $\frac{1}{4}$  and  $\frac{1}{4}$ .

Add the numerator.

$$\frac{1}{4} + \frac{1}{4} = \frac{2}{4}$$

The restaurant served  $\frac{2}{4}$  of a pot of soup.
