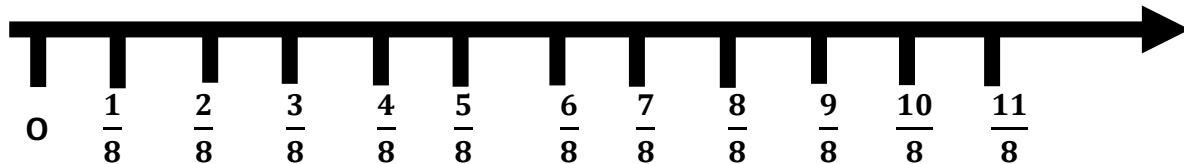


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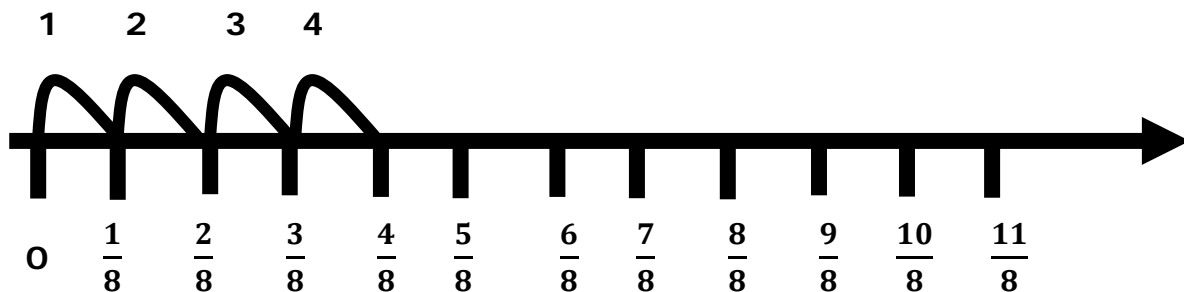
**Fractions and Whole Numbers in Words and Visuals - Step-by-Step Lesson****Multiplying Fractions on a Numbers Line:**

What is  $\frac{1}{8}$  multiplied by 4? Use the numbers line to help you.

**Answer:**

Each step of the numbers line is a unit of  $\frac{1}{8}$ . So it stands to reason that 4 of those steps would be equal to  $4 \times \frac{1}{8}$ ?

Let's jump 4 steps on the numbers line. Start from 0.



This tells us that  $4 \times \frac{1}{8} = \frac{4}{8}$
