

Understanding Math Expressions - Guided Lesson Explanation**Explanation#1**

To answer this, it's best to run the expression with and without the part they are asking about.

$$1) 2 - 8 = -6 \quad \text{or} \quad 2) 2 - (48) = -46$$

Now, we look to the possible choices.

The expression will be six times more gets subtracted is the best choice.

So, the answer will be 'd'.

Explanation#2

$$21 \div 7 + 12$$

Break it into parts first and remember PEMDAS.

Part a) $21 \div 7$

The quotient of twenty-one by seven.

Part b) $+ 12$

Twelve more.

Put it all together-

Twelve more than the quotient of twenty one divided by seven.

Explanation#3

Let's denote chocolates as 'c'

He ate 10 chocolates and 20 still left with him.

Step 3) if we deduct 10 from c we will get 20.

So the equation will be ' $c - 10 = 20$ '.

The answer is 'c'.
