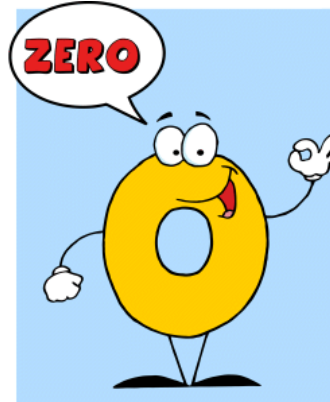


Addition of Decimals

When adding decimals, don't forget your old friend, zero!



It helps to put in zeroes as placeholders to make the numbers line up.

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{Example: } 208.9 \\ + 45.899 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

Can be changed to:

$$\begin{array}{r} 208.900 \\ +45.899 \\ \hline \end{array}$$
