A. A "drum" is a container which holds a large amount of milk. We are measuring the volume of a liquid (milk). Liters are an appropriate unit to measure liquid substances.

B. A distance between two cities is a very long distance, so we are on the lookout for large units of distance. Meters are a possible unit, but they are not as large as miles. We use the unit of miles for measuring long distances.
