

### Guided Lesson Explanation for More, Less, or Equal

**Answering # 1 and 2** – To answer this we will need to know how many boys and girls there are. We can count them to learn these numbers.



After counting, we learn that there are:

6 boys and 7 girls.

**From this we can see that:**

- a) there are not equal amounts of boys and girls.
- b) There are more girls than boys.
- c) There are less boys than girls.

Now put this to work in the questions:


- 1. There are **less** boys.
- 2. There are **more** girls.

**Answering #3** – To do this we will need to count all of the groups. When we find two or more groups that have the same number of skateboards, we have found the answer.






**Group A**

When have completed our counts we find that:

Group A has 5 members. Group B has 3 members. Group C has 4 members.  
Group D has 5 members.

Group A and D both have 5 members. That means they are equal.
