## **Two Step Equations in Words Lesson Practice Sheet**

## In above problem:

I - Define a variable.

Let *n* represent the number.

II - Simplify the sentence.

a number divided by 
$$5 \rightarrow \frac{n}{5}$$

Is eight 
$$\longrightarrow$$
 = 8

III - Write the equation.

$$\underline{n} - 2 = 8$$

IV – Solve the equation.

$$\frac{n}{2}$$
 - 2 + 2 = 8 + 2 (add 2 to each side)

$$\underline{n} \times 5 = 10 \times 5$$
 (multiply each side by 5)

$$n = 50$$

- 1 Seven more than four times a number is twenty-seven.
- 2 Four more than a number divided by 3 is twelve.
