Metric System - Step-by-Step Lesson

Jacky is picking flowers in his garden. He needs 1 kg of flowers for decoration. He has 750 grams of flowers now. How much more does she need?

Explain your answer.



Explanation:

We know:

$$1 \text{ kg} = 1000 \text{ grams}$$

Jacky needs 1000 grams of flowers for decoration, but she has 750 grams.

To calculate the remaining flowers:

$$1000 \text{ gm} - 750 \text{ gm} = 250 \text{ gm}$$

So, the Jacky needs 250 grams of more flowers for decoration.
