Counting Dollars and Change Lesson

How much money is present? Write the amount in dollars.

This is one dollar. It is worth 100 cents.

\$1 or \$1.00



This coin is called one cent or a penny. We write it as 1¢.



This coin is called nickel. It is worth 5 cents or 5¢.



This is five dollars. It is worth 500 cents.

\$5 or \$5.00



This coin is called a dime. It is worth 10 cents-10¢.

First, determine the value of each coin and the dollars. Write the total amount of dollars, then a point, then the cents. Use the dollar symbol before the dollar amounts. Do not use the ¢ symbol.

In the above question there is only single **1 dollar** note and there are 2 dimes which is equal to $10 + 10 = 20¢$.

Therefore the total amount in dollars will be \$1.20.

Ans. \$1.20
