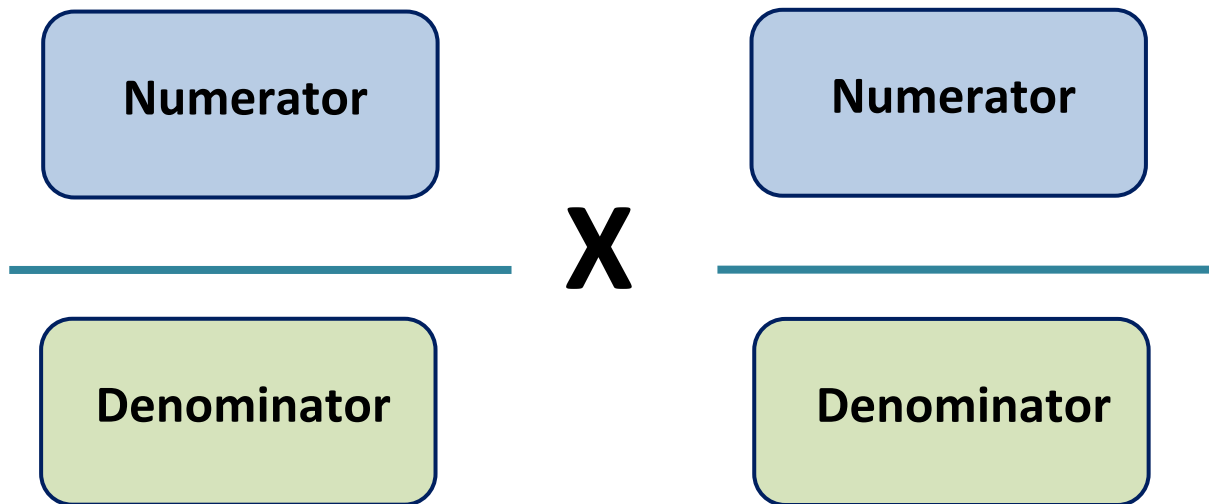


Multiplying Mixed Numbers Organizer

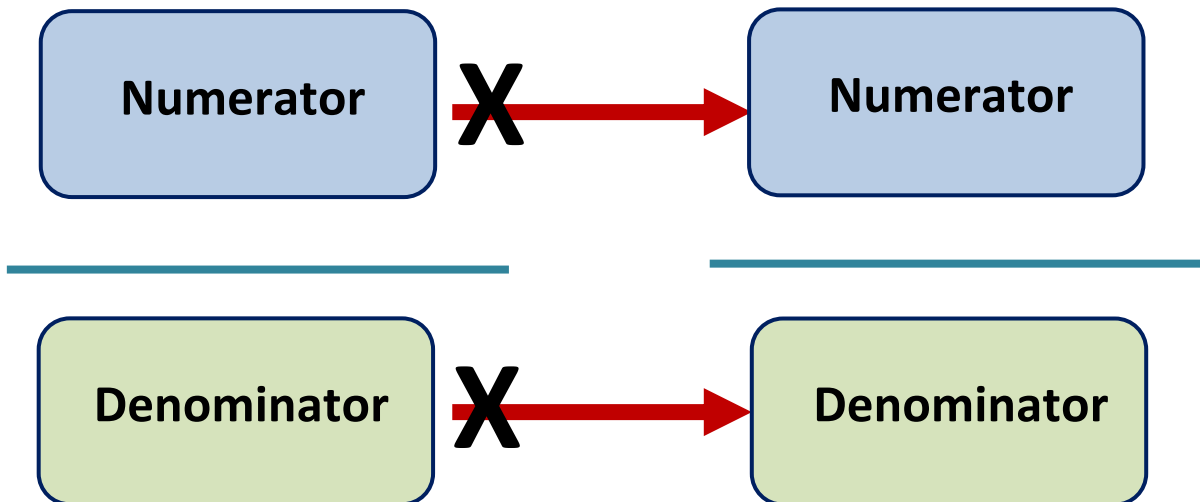
1. Convert the whole numbers of the mixed number(s) to improper fractions.
2. Multiply the denominator by the whole number and add the numerator.
3. Place the answer over the denominator.

Note: For whole numbers, place the whole number over one.



Multiply the numerators together. Multiply the denominators together.

Multiply straight across the problem.



When you complete your multiplication, simplify the remaining values, if possible.
