2. Gina's Fudge Shop produces 100 pounds of fudge per day, and The Fudge Factory Candy Shop makes 300 pounds of fudge per day. Write the ratio of fudge produced by the two candy shops per day.

3. In Wisconsin, the average snowfall was 50 inches for the year while in Illinois, the average snowfall was 34 inches. Write the ratio of snowfall in Wisconsin and Illinois for the year.

4. Last year, 1,345 bicyclists showed up to the bicycle race. This year, only 690 bicyclists showed up. Write the ratio of the number of bicyclists that showed up to the bicycle race for the past two years.

5. Paula's Flowers sells 39 arrangements per week. The flower shop down the street sells 50 arrangements per week. Write the ratio of the number of flower arrangements sold at the two flower shops.

6. The monkey exhibit at the zoo has 12 chimpanzees and 5 apes. Write the ratio of the number of chimpanzees and apes in the monkey exhibit.

7. The aquarium at the bank has 25 fish and the fish tank at Jamie's houses has 10 fish. Write the ratio of the number of fish at the bank and at Jamie's house.
