

## What Is A Fact Family?

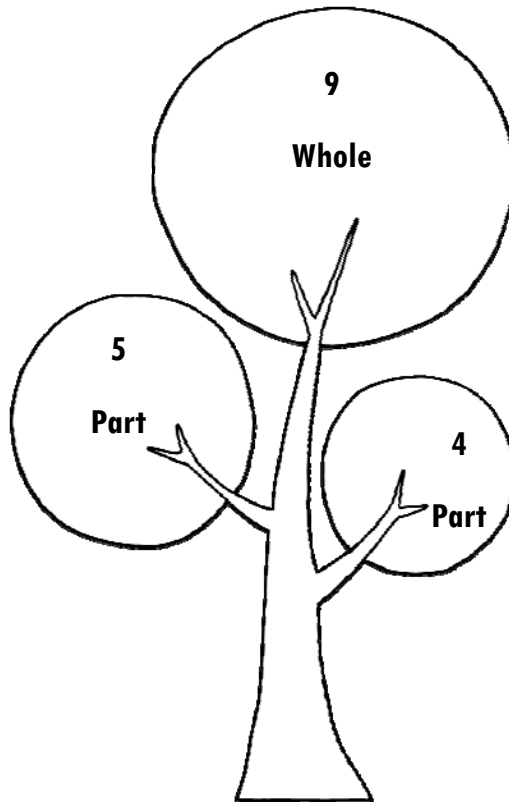
Fact families are a set of three numbers that are directly related to another.

They can consist of a whole (the largest number) and two parts (two smallest numbers). Fact families follow this pattern:

$$\text{Whole} - \text{Part} = \text{Other Part}$$

$$\text{Part} + \text{Part} = \text{Whole}$$

Example of a Fact Family



**Addition Facts**

$$4 + 5 = 9$$

$$5 + 4 = 9$$

**Subtraction Facts**

$$9 - 5 = 4$$

$$9 - 4 = 5$$
